Pupils will be interpreting the past from the Romans point of view as well as the warrior queen's point of view and understanding why viewpoints differed. The pupils will also be learning about the great warrior Rama and the beautiful princess Sita and their importance within the Hindu religion and the festival of Diwali.

<p>The pupils will be learning about who the Anglo- Saxons were and why they inhabited England in the Middle Ages. They will be investigating what life was like in Britain during this time and comparing how much has changed. They will also be learning about one of the most important archaeological discoveries ever made: The royal burial site discovered at Sutton Hoo. Pupils will be learning all about the discovery in 1939 and how it changed understanding of English History at this time.</p>			<p>In Year 3, the pupils will be learning all about Henri Matisse. They will be observing some of his collages in detail and using this as inspiration to recreate patterns. They will be exploring colour and shape and the effect that this can have on the overall print. They will be learning about the characteristics of Matisse’s work, focusing on the techniques of: coiling, overlapping, tessellation, mosaic and montage. The final outcome being a collage, created by the pupils using different textures from the natural environment. Pupils will be learning all about Earthquakes and Volcanoes. They will be using images to recreate a 3D model of the Earth’s layers and then cutting it open to identify the different layers.</p>
